Information.

The Police Trail Competition 2025 will be held on **Saturday 13 December 2025** as from **07:00 hours**. The departure will be given at Petrin. The competition is open to all members of the Force including Rodrigues Division.

Itinerary.

2. The itineraries will be Petrin, Mare Longue Loop, Macabé Loop and back to Petrin. The track is put up at **Annex A**.

Category of Participating Teams.

- 3. The category of teams competing for the above competition will be as follows:-
 - (i) Inter-Divisions Trail Competition:

- (iii) Women Race: Woman Police Officers will participate as individuals in three categories as hereunder: -
 - (a) Between 18 29 yrs;
 - (b) Between 30 40 yrs; and,
 - (c) Above 40 yrs.

Note: All participants over the age of 40 yrs will prior to the competition submit to the Sports Officer a Medical Certificate as to their fitness as well as presentation of their National Identity Card to participate in the above Police Trail.

Distance and Timing.

- 4. The distance and timing will be as follows: -
 - (i) Branches & Divisions 13.5 km (departure at 07:50 hrs)
 - (ii) Women & Above 60 yrs 8 km (departure at 08:20 hrs)
 - (iii) Family Fun Run 5 km (departure at 08:25 hrs)

5. Entries/Participation.

Entries will be as follows: -

- (a) Divisions: Each team may enter a maximum of 7 runners. The score of the five (5) best runners will count towards the Division Championship;
- (b) Branches: Each team may enter a maximum of 10 runners. The score of the five (5) best runners will count towards the Branch Championship; and,
- (c) Women and Above 60 yrs: Divisional Commanders and Branch Officers are to submit the names of the runners working under their orders to PC 6772 Hoolash (PHQ) on fax no 212 3291 or email address ccphq.mpf@govmu.org by 10:00 hrs on Friday 05 December 2025.

Tracking Officials.

6. List of Track Officials are put up at **Annex B**. All Officials are to be present at **06:00 hrs** on the day of the competition.

Briefing.

- 7. All Team Captains and Track Officials are to attend a meeting which will be held by the Sports Officer on **Tuesday 09 December 2025** at **10:00 hrs** at Petrin. Representatives of Central Division and Traffic Branch as well as IC Provost should also attend.
- 8. The Team Captains will enter the names and other particulars of competitors in the relevant entry form shown at **Annex C** and will thereafter, hand over same to the Athletic Officer on the day of the briefing. On receipt of entries, numerals will be remitted to Team Captains.

Allocation of Scores.

9. Points for the Inter-Division and Branch Championships will be allocated as follows: -

The team scoring the least number of points will be declared the winner.

Prizes.

- 11. Medals will be presented to Divisions and Branches as follows: -
 - (a) Each member of the Winning Team;
 - (b) Each member of the Runner-Up & 3rd place Teams;
 - (c) Ten (10) Best Runners for Branches;
 - (d) Ten (10) Best Runners for Divisions;
 - (e) Five (5) Best Woman Police Officers for each category; and,
 - (f) Five (5) Best Runners for participants above 60 yrs.
- 12. In addition to the above, the Winning, Runner–Up and the Third place Teams (i.e both for Division and Branch Championship) will be presented with a Trophy.

Responsibilities.

13. The responsibilities of Divisional Commanders, Branch Officers and Individuals concerned will be as follows: -

- (a) DCP (A)
- To arrange for refreshments for the guests, officials and participants in liaison with the Sports Officer, Mess Secretary, Manager Financial Operations, Manager (Procurement & Supply) and Chief Catering Administrator; and,
- In conjunction with Manager (P & S), to arrange for the purchase of prizes in liaison with Sports Manager and Manager Financial Operations (MFO).
- (b) CO SMF
- To arrange for Start Gun and blanks for the start and to detail an officer to be responsible thereof;
- To make provisions for 2 tents (PL 240), 10 tables, 100 chairs, 2 Outers, blackboard as well as sitting accommodation for the guests;
- RSM to arrange for parading the participants/officials before and after the competition;
- To arrange for pointers in conjunction with OC PTS; and,
- To provide announcers (PS 5991 Baungaleea and PC 2470 Empeigne).

- To arrange for a Medical Team under the charge of a PMO together with an ambulance to be on standby at Petrin;

- To arrange for Medical Examination of participants who are above the age of 40 years prior to the day of the competition; and,

- To detail four (4) Woman Police Constables to act as Usherettes. They will report in Dress No. 2 to the Sports Officer at 08:00 hrs on the day of the competition at Petrin.

- To arrange for pointers in conjunction with Sports Manager.
- (h) OC Comms
- To provide loud hailers, public address system and 12 radios to Officials in liaison with CPTI SMF;
- To make provision for two Television Sets on the day of the competition at Petrin; and,

- As from 06:00 hrs to arrange for a Generator for supply of electricity on the day of the competition.
- (i) OC PRDU To arrange for Drone to cover the competition.
- (j) OC Police To arrange for two (2) Buglers and two (2)
 Band Drummers to perform during the Prize
 Giving Ceremony.
- (k) PP & RO To arrange for Press Coverage.
- (I) OIC SOCO To arrange for Video Recording, and Photographs.
- (m) OIC Transport

 To provide two 25-seater buses for conveyance of Managerial Staffs and Officials. One from Line Barracks and the second one from ERS HQ to Petrin in liaison with the Sports Manager.
- (n) OIC Drawing To arrange for decoration in liaison with Office Provost.
- (o) IC Provost To arrange for twenty-five (25) metal barriers and Police tape at Petrin; and,
 - To clean the ground at Petrin after the competition.

Note: Divisions and Branches will bear their respective colours during the competition.
